2 Peter 1:1-4

1. We have an equal standing with the apostles. (2 Peter 1:1-2)

2. The knowledge of God reveals His power to give us everything we need.
(2 Peter 1:3-4)

Table Talk

- 1) What are some things that you wish you knew but you do not or cannot know? Why does it bother us not to know things? How does Peter help us recognize that the things we know are better and more important than the things we do not know?
- 2) In what ways are we exactly like the apostles (1:1)? How is that reassuring?
- 3) How is our grace and peace multiplied in our lives? What can we do to increase our knowledge of Jesus Christ? What things should change in your life to increase that knowledge? (1:2)
- 4) What is the way that God's power gives us all things that relate to life and godliness? How does this verse assure us that we are not lacking in the knowledge or power we need to live or to be godly? (1:3)
- 5) God's glory and excellence gives us promises that Peter does not detail. What are some of those great and precious promises? Peter does detail the purpose of those promises. What is that purpose? (1:4)
- 6) In a world of "not knowing," how do these beginning verses in 2 Peter change how you will live this week?
