## Table Talk

- 1) Have you ever known someone who blamed God for the consequences of their own disobedience? How did that affect them? What is the “crazy cycle” that Pastor Scott described? (vv. 1-5)
- 2) Why is it important to remind the next generation what the LORD has done for us? Why is it important to teach the next generation how to know the LORD? What are you doing to remind the next generation what the LORD has done? What are you doing to teach the next generation how to know the LORD? What implications does this section have for our church’s children’s and youth ministries? (vv. 6-10)
- 3) What are the consequences of disobedience? (vv. 11-15) How might we observe such consequences in our own culture?
- 4) What kind of “partial revivals” occurred during the Judges? Why would we call it “partial revival”? (vv. 15-19) What can we do to make revival more permanent in our lives?
- 5) What did God do as a result of partial revival? (vv. 20-23) How do constant problems drive us back to the Lord? Have you ever experienced that kind of grace from God?
