Table Talk

- In what areas of your life do you have hope, and in what areas do you feel hopeless? What songs could you sing from Scripture to remind you of God's strength and power? How will you respond to the Gospel in song, word, and deed? (v.18)
- 2) Where is your joy bound up? What are the outcomes of your sufferings? What is the certainty of your salvation in Christ alone? Are you confident that God will complete the good work of salvation in your life? How and why? (v.19-20)
- 3) How do we manage the trouble, fears, and trials in our souls? Are our social, economic, and political systems enough to help people, or do we need a spiritual work to be done? What practical ways can you bring worship into your home through singing, reading God's Word, and prayer? (v.21-24)
- 4) In what specific ways has God positioned you in your life to be a blessing to others? Through your school, work, family, or hobbies? How is your testimony unique in being an encouragement to others as one of God's own emissaries? What is your hope in life and death, and what song has God put on your heart to worship Him? (v.25-26)
