## Table Talk

- 1) List the attributes of God emphasized in verses 19:1-9. Why is God truly the only one worthy of praise? Do we feel that at times God's salvation, glory, and power are just not enough? What does it mean that these three things "belong" to God? Why did the heavenly multitude sing praises to God? What are some reasons that you have praised God for recently? (v.1-3)
- 2) Who are the twenty-four elders? What do the four living creatures represent? What is different about their worship versus the multitudes? How ought we praise the Lord on the throne? (v.4-5)
- 3) How can we remove unwanted idols in our lives that are beginning to reign and lord over us? Why is it so hard for us to give God the glory? What are some practical ways we can be preparing ourselves as the bride of Christ today? Do you find it more difficult to praise God in the good times or difficult times? Why? How does our anticipation of Revelation 19 help us praise Him during both good times and difficult times? (v.6-8)
- 4) Who is called "blessed"? When was the last time you looked forward to a meal? What do meals teach us about intimacy and relationships? (v.9)
