

# Oakie Video Competition 2024 Official Rules & Info Packet

#### 2024 Oakie Video Contest

The Oakie Video Contest was created more than a decade ago as a fun way to get our students interested in the creative use of media to communicate the gospel message around the world. In the process, they learn how to work as a team, use new technology, and learn a sense of storytelling in communicating a message to an audience. It still one of our goals that our students would use technology, media, their words, and their lives to influence the world for Christ.

#### The Official Rules 2024

- 1. All videos must be submitted by February 18, 2024
- 2. All videos must be no longer than 10 minutes in length
- 3. All videos must be "family friendly" and in good taste (Philippians 4:8) i.e. No "gore", sexual inuendo etc.

  "Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things." (Philippians 4:8, ESV)
- 4. All videos must be in digital format (flash drive, email an Mp4 etc.) and turned in to Pastor Walt on or before February 18, 2024, unless you've received an extension. Need help? Contact us!
- 5. More than one entry is allowed.
- 6. All videos will be judged by a volunteer panel of judges from the Young Adult Ministries who have watched movies before.
- 7. All judges' decisions are final.
- 8. All names of your video team must be included with the video submission, and at least one member of your team must be a regular attender of EWO Youth Ministries.
- 9. <u>A representative from your team must be prepared to make an acceptance speech if your video wins.</u>
- 10. All videos must have a title AND be submitted under one of the specified categories.
  - a. Comedy
  - b. Take Off (of a TV Show, Movie, YouTube etc.)
  - c. Documentary
  - d. Drama
  - e. Music
  - f. Christian Theme
- 11. We reserve the right to reject any videos submitted which are deemed inappropriate. (See Rule #3 above)
- 12. Please submit one of the following "Judge's Sheets" with the shaded part filled in appropriately with your video submission. (We've included three in case you have more than one entry. See Walt for more if needed.)
- 13. Have fun!
- 14. NEW THIS YEAR: There will be a \$50 cash prize for the winners of the "Christian Theme" category.
