Table Talk

- 1) What are some ways that we can be ashamed of the Gospel or of God's people? What is the only way to share in suffering? (v.8)
- 2) What has God done for us, according to verse 9? What is a wrong reason often given for God's work for us? What is the right reason?
- 3) How far back can we trace God's purpose and grace in our lives? (v.9) What is the key way that God's purpose and grace was revealed? (v.10)
- 4) What two things did Christ accomplish? (v.10b) In what sense was death abolished by Christ? How was life and immortality revealed by Christ?
- 5) Why does the Gospel require our boldest and best efforts? (vv.11-12) How can we give a better effort at communicating the Gospel? How can we give a better effort at trusting God in the midst of challenges?
- 6) How does the testimony of Mehdi Dibaj inspire you to be bold for the Gospel?
