Table Talk

- 1) What pattern of sound words of the Gospel have you received? From whom did you receive it? Who is following the pattern of your sound words of the Gospel? Why is it important to think both about those whom we are following and those who follow us? (v. 13)
- 2) What are ways that you personally can guard the good deposit of the Gospel? What are ways that our church can guard that good deposit? What role does the Holy Spirit have in helping us guard the good deposit of the Gospel? (v. 14)
- 3) What negative and positive examples of faith have you seen in people in the church? What are you doing to provide a positive example of faith in Christ to others? (vv. 15-18) How will you bless fellow brothers and sisters whom you know when it comes that they are persecuted?
- 4) Write down your testimony of how you became a believer in Jesus, using the basic outline of life before Christ, how you believed in Christ, and your life now with Christ. Ask someone else to read it so that it can be sharpened and made very clear.
