- 1) What is the immediate purpose of the book of Deuteronomy? How was Deuteronomy used in daily Jewish life? How does the New Testament use Deuteronomy? What key themes from Deuteronomy are emphasized in the New Testament?
- 2) How is the understanding of Deuteronomy as a treaty or covenant that God makes with His people helpful to understand the organization of the book? Why should we be both excited and apprehensive by the idea of "covenant"?
- 3) How do we see the power of preaching in this book? How do we see the value of listening to God's Word? Why might the wisdom of the outgoing leader Moses be valuable to the Israelites as they are about to enter the Promised Land without him?
